Admission Procedure –Selection Criteria

13th batch of PGDM (ABM) programme commencing in the second week of June, 2020 is as given below:

The selection to PGDM-ABM programme is based on Entrance Examination which is comprising of

1. Latest valid test score of STATE CET/ CAT / MAT / XAT / ATMA / CMAT of AICTE at the time of application
2. Group Discussion
3. Personal Interview.

Securing minimum prescribed marks in Group Discussion and Personal Interview are compulsory to become eligible for taking admission.

Note:

Interested candidates are advised to apply and appear the referred national level test directly and apply to URICM in the prescribed application form with valid score on or before 31st March, 2020.

Eligibility

- i) Any graduate from a recognized University, with minimum education of 15 years (10+2+3) full time with at least 50% marks for the General / OBC (non creamy) / 45% marks for SC / ST candidates in Graduation.
- ii) Latest Valid Test scores of any one of the National Level Tests –STATE CET/ CAT / MAT / XAT / ATMA /CMAT) at the time of application. These guidelines may get modified / subject to be modified depending upon AICTE guidelines from time to time.
- iii) The percentage obtained by the candidate in the Bachelor's Degree would be based on the practice followed by the University / institution from where the candidate has obtained the degree.
- iv) Applicants who have appeared for bachelor's degree examination and awaiting results may also apply subject to fulfilment of conditions by 14/08/2020.
- v) Reservation of seats for OBC (Non Creamy) / SC / ST / Physically Disability persons as per Govt. of India rules.

HOW TO APPLY

The prescribed application form may be downloaded from the website and apply with valid score of STATE CET/CAT / MAT / XAT / ATMA / /CMAT before **31st March 2020** by post along with demand draft of Rs. 500/- in favour of "The Director, URICM, Gandhinagar".

The Group Discussion and Personal Interviews may be conducted at Pune, Nashik, Ahmednagar, Kolhapur, Akola ,Baramati, Solapur, Aurangabad, Agra, Meerut, Lucknow and other places on the basis of number of students during April & May 2020, subject to sufficient number of students opting for it.
